GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED WHEN COLLEGE IS REOPENED

- Body Temperature of all students entering the campus will be monitored.
- Students entering college bus must wear masks and must sanitize hands before entering the bus.
- Covid-19 protocols (Social Distancing, wearing face Mask, Washing and sanitizing hands in regular intervals) should be strictly followed inside the campus and hostels by the students. **(Strict Covid-19 protocol should be maintained in the canteen during lunch session).**
- Students must wear masks all the time. They are advised to carry their own sanitizers and water bottles.
- Students are not permitted to wander in the campus.
- Students must bring their own stationery required for the internal exams. Sharing of any items is strictly prohibited inside the exam hall.
- Due to the present situation, sports and other recreation facilities are not open for use for students in college and hostel premises.
- Students are not permitted to leave the campus during the class hours (9.30 am to 4.30 pm)
- Students having symptoms of fever or suspecting virus infection, should immediately report the same to the Monitoring committee members
- Maximum only 12 students are permitted in a laboratory at a time. For Computer laboratory 50% of the maximum occupancy shall be permitted.
- The classes are divided into four batches in CSE and ME and two batches in CE and ECE one batch each in EEE and EI.

GUIDELINES FOR ACCOMADATION OF STUDENTS IN COLLEGE HOSTELS

- Students staying in hostels will have to abide by the rules and regulations, specifically intimated to them by hostel authorities, regarding the preventive measures taken in connection with the pandemic.
- Inmates can only move out of hostel premises for the purpose of attending the classes and should be back at the hostel immediately after the classes. They are also directed to undergo compulsory hostel stay till the end of the contact classes (18-01-2021 to 05-02-2021).
- Students must complete all academic works including report printing / photocopy within the working hours.
- Inmates are not permitted to group together for any purpose while staying in the hostels.
- Symptomatic students should not be permitted to stay in the hostel under any circumstances.
- No outsider is allowed to enter the hostel premises.
